We also want to stay connected to each other, so take the opportunity to join our Zoom coffee hours and other online gatherings, and to reach out to fellow parishioners.

This year, we ask of you three things:

PRAY. Please continue to keep our parish community in your prayers and worship with us online. Prayerfully consider how you can support St. Olave's ministry. Your Christmas gift could put us over the top for 2020.
