

NEW TENANTS TO ST. STEWARDSHIP UPDATE: The graph below compares the amount of givings budgeted for all of 2019 with the amount received to date. We typically receive a large percentage of our gifts in the last three months of the year, and we are hopeful that we can significantly close the gap before the end of December. These figures do <u>not</u> include additional substantial gifts received this year toward the cost of replacing the boiler (\$41,520) and the cost of the curacy (\$8000).

Flowers are needed for: Sunday October 20, and Sunday October 27 (including Evensong for St. Simon and St. Jude at 4:00 p.m.), and Sunday November 3 (All Souls).
