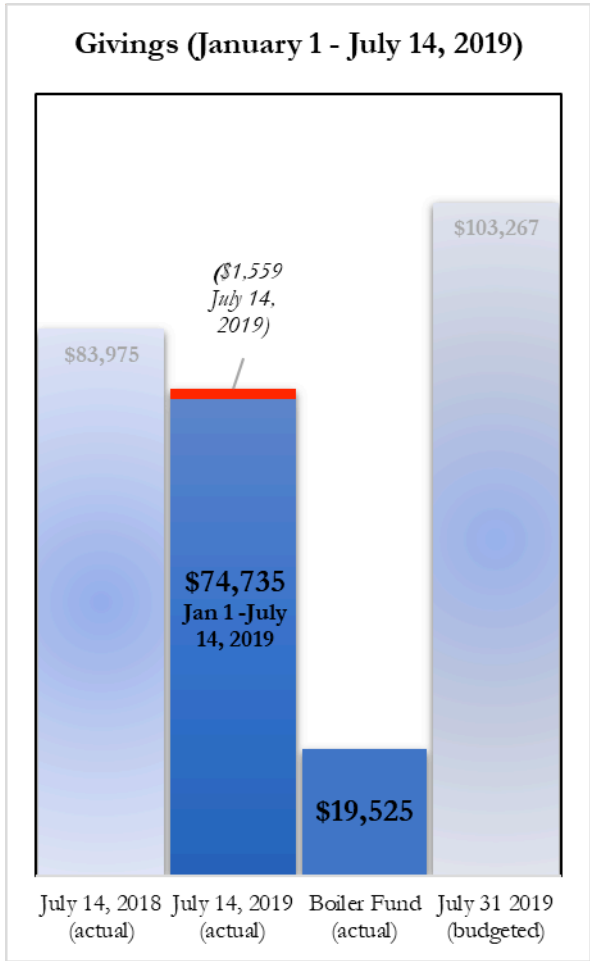
**FLOWERS ON THE ALTAR:** Parishioners are encouraged to donate altar flowers **throughout the year**. It can be a meaningful way to remember someone who has died or to give thanks to God for a special anniversary or blessing in your life. A notice will be placed in the bulletin on that day. You may donate funds or purchase flowers yourself. Please contact the office to arrange a date, a minimum of two weeks in advance. Purchased flowers should be dropped off no later than Sunday morning by 9:30 am, or through mutually convenient arrangement. **Flowers are needed for: Sunday August 4, Sunday August 11, and Sunday August 18.**

**GREETERS NEEDED:** Greeters, also sometimes known as sides people, are often a worshipper's first point of contact. They hand out bulletins, take up the collection and black prayer binder, and help count the collection. They make an important first impression! Greeters are needed in July and August to join the Wardens on duty. **BOILER REPLACEMENT:** As you may recall, at this year's Annual Vestry Meeting we discussed the need to begin saving for the eventual replacement of our 44 year-old boiler. Unfortunately, we have since learned the boiler will not last another season and must be replaced this summer. Property Chairperson, Sheila Tait, is currently acquiring three estimates. However, we are anticipating the cost to be approximately \$70,000. This will include removing the old boiler, installing the new one, installing a dual zone system (so that upstairs and downstairs can be set to different temperatures and thereby save money on heating), lining the chimney to bring it up to code, and all the requisite plumbing and electrical work. The funds to cover this expense will be withdrawn from our Capital Fund. However, donations toward the boiler would be gratefully received and will help reduce the amount drawn from our investments. **Stewardship Update**

Our budgeted givings target for July 31, 2019, is \$103,267 (see fourth column). Until the end of July, we will be reporting weekly givings (second column) in the announcements so that you can see our progress and consider how you can help. The first column shows givings from the same time last year. The third column represents additional gifts made toward the cost of replacing the boiler. (Total estimated cost: \$70,000.)
