2. The Roman soldiers beat Jesus and made fun of Him. What kind of crown did they put on his head? What colour was the robe that they put on Him?
3. What was the name of the man who helped Jesus carry His cross?
4. When they arrived at Golgotha, the soldiers crucified Jesus. That means they nailed Jesus' hands and feet to the cross with a hammer. How many other men were crucified next to Jesus?
5. Standing by the cross was the beloved disciple of Jesus. What was this disciples name? (*hint: the author of one of the Four Gospels. You read his account of the crucifixion.*)
6. After Jesus died on the cross what did one of the soldiers do with his spear?
7. Who buried Jesus?
